CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

10. Legal basis, eligibility and rules of origin

For this contract award procedure, participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium – of candidates/tenderers) which are effectively established in Ethiopia.

11. Number of tenders

No more than one tender can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting a tender). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded.

No restrictions may be made in the number of lots a tenderer can be awarded.

The tenderer may submit a tender for one lot only, several lots or all of the lots, but only one tender. Contracts will be awarded lot by lot/lots.

Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot.

12. Grounds for exclusion

As part of the tender, tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the tender form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.6.10.1. of the practical guide.

Tenderer included in the lists of EU restrictive measures (see Section 2.4. of the PRAG) at the moment of the award decision cannot be awarded the contract.

13. Sub-contracting

Subcontracting is not allowed.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to the tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole if not specified otherwise.

1) Economic and financial capacity of the tenderer

The invited potential suppliers to this Flexible Simplified Procedure have already cleared their Economic and Financial Capacity during the vendor eligibility validation process.

2) Professional capacity of the tenderer

The invited potential suppliers to this Flexible Simplified Procedure have already been approved for their Professional Capacity during the vendor eligibility validation process.

3) Technical capacity of tenderer

The invited potential suppliers to this Flexible Simplified Procedure have already been approved for their Technical Capacity during the vendor eligibility validation process.

19. Tender format and details to be provided

Tenders must be submitted using the standard tender form.

The tenderers do not need to be accompanied by a declaration on honour on exclusion and selection criteria as the invited potential suppliers to this Flexible Simplified Procedure have already submitted it during the vendor eligibility validation process.

Any additional documentation (brochure, letter, etc.) sent with a tender will not be taken into consideration.

20. How tenders may be submitted

Tenders must be submitted in English exclusively to the contracting authority, using the means specified in point 10 of the instructions to tenderers.

Tenders submitted by any other means will not be considered.

By submitting a tender tenderers accept to receive notification of the outcome of the procedure by electronic means.

21. Alteration or withdrawal of tenders

Tenderers may alter or withdraw their tenders by written notification prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. No tender may be altered after this deadline.

Any such notification of alteration or withdrawal shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with point 15 of the instructions to tenderers.

22. Operational language

All written communications for this tender procedure and contract must be in English.
